NOTES:

Assets valued on replacement value basis for insurance purposes.

Don't include VAT on asset register, value to include delivery costs.

For the purposes of the annual return fixed assets should be valued at cost (or a sensible proxy, e.g. earliest known insurance value, where cost is not available).

Neither depreciation nor revaluation should be made, so the value of fixed assets does not change from year to year unless they are improved or disposed off. (Advice from SLCC)

NPTS advised all land should be value at £1, regardless of how it was acquired.
